**Bernd Reitmeier:** General Manager startup FACTORY Kunshan

Startup Factory is a business incubator for small and mid-sized European enterprises that are looking for assembly or production facilities, a repair workshop or a job shop in China to extend their business activities.

Juergen Heise: Head of Asia Pacific LEHVOSS Group
